Communique of the Coordinating Bureau of Non-Aligned Movement regarding the convening of an Israeli Cabinet meeting on 26th December 2021 in the Occupied Syrian Golan

7 January 2022

The Non-Aligned Movement Coordinating Bureau condemns in the strongest terms the convening of an Israeli Cabinet meeting on 26th December 2021 in the Occupied Syrian Golan, as well as its statement to spend 317 million dollars to double the numbers of settlers in the occupied Syrian Golan by building two new settlements. This provocative meeting and plan are escalatory and grave violation of international law and relevant United Nations resolutions, particularly Security Council resolution 497 (1981).

The Non-Aligned Movement Coordinating Bureau reiterates that all measures and actions taken, or to be taken by Israel, the occupying power, that purports to alter the legal, physical, and demographic status of the Occupied Syrian Golan and its institutional structure, as well as the Israeli measures to apply its jurisdiction and administration there, are null and void and have no legal effect.

The Non-Aligned Movement Coordinating Bureau reiterates the Movement's position reflected in the final document of the 18th Summit of Heads of State and Government of the Non Aligned Movement held in Baku, Republic Azerbaijan 25 - 26 October 2019, regarding the Occupied Syrian Golan, including its demand that Israel comply with the UN Security Council resolution 497 (1981) and fully withdraw from the occupied Syrian Golan to the line of 4 June 1967 in accordance with the UN Security Council resolutions 242 and 338.
