COMMUNIQUÉ OF THE COORDINATING BUREAU OF THE NON-ALIGNED MOVEMENT (NAM) ON THE SITUATION IN THE PLURINATIONAL STATE OF BOLIVIA

- 1. The Coordinating Bureau of the Non-Aligned Movement (CoB-NAM) recalls the Special Declaration of the XVIII Summit of Heads of State and Government of the Non-Aligned Movement (NAM) on the Presidential Elections on Bolivia, adopted on 26 October 2019, in Baku, Republic of Azerbaijan.
- 2. The Coordinating Bureau of the Non-Aligned Movement (CoB-NAM) expresses its deep concern about the latest developments in the Plurinational State of Bolivia and, in that regard, urges relevant national authorities to ensure the safety and security of all Bolivian citizens and the respect of their human rights, particularly their right to life, especially that of President Evo Morales Ayma, the members of his cabinet and other government officials, as well as of his supporters.
- 3. The Coordinating Bureau of the Non-Aligned Movement (CoB-NAM) looks forward to the peaceful resolution of the current situation in Bolivia through political dialogue amongst all actors and within the framework of the provisions of the Political Constitution of the Plurinational State of Bolivia.
